- (ii)    Officers shown below, in normal type indicate officers working in JAG & waiting for SG.
- (iii)    Figures shown within Box □ means officers waiting for JA grade.

I don't feel, exact calculation need to be given, as the graphical status indicated is enough for making every thing very clear. If so desired by fellow officers, we can discuss the highlight in next projection.
